Mission Statement

The Urban Schools are a vital mission of the Catholic Church in the Diocese of Covington. These Schools provide an exemplary Christ-centered moral and academic education to the young and provide a foundation that contributes to present and future solidarity and quality of life in the urban areas of Northern Kentucky.



The ACUE Parishes

The thirteen urban parishes of the Diocese comprise the Covington Deanery. These parishes are also known as ACUE parishes. Whether or not they host an ACUE school on their property, the ACUE parishes each provide 30% of their weekly collections toward the operation of the six diocesan grade schools of the Deanery. This support from our urban parishes for our ACUE schools amounted to approximately \$770,000 during the 2016-2017 academic year. Until recent years, the urban parish support of our schools was as high as 40% of their weekly collection. Fortunately, the generosity of donors to the annual ACUE Fund has been instrumental in reducing this figure to a more manageable level. It is important to mention that our host parishes must also maintain their ACUE school buildings and grounds as they are parish assets and not owned by ACUE.

ACUE is sincerely appreciative of the blessings each parish provides to our students. Further reduction in parish financial participation continues as an ongoing goal of the ACUE Fund.



Dear Friends:

With this publication, ACUE celebrates your generosity, your dedication to urban Catholic education and your compassionate concern for the children and families we serve. I join ACUE in thanking each of our donors. We are humbled by the significance of your investment in the ACUE mission.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the members of the ACUE Development Advisory Board. This dedicated group of volunteers has helped to significantly raise the profile of our urban elementary schools and has helped to keep the doors of our faith-based schools open as an important educational alternative for neighborhood children.

Next, I give my thanks to Advisory Board member, Tim Rawe, who graciously chaired the 2016-2017 ACUE Annual Fund. The primary purpose of the Annual Fund is to raise tuition assistance dollars to offset the more than \$1.5 million in aid needed annually at the ACUE schools. Tim, a proud ACUE school alum, along with a dedicated team of 61 volunteers, raised yet another record amount for our schools and students. To give you a sense of the significance of their accomplishment, the Development Advisory Board's 2014 Strategic Plan set an aggressive goal to reach \$1 million in annual contributions within five years. I congratulate Tim and his team in securing \$1,045,000 in gifts and pledges and in doing so two years ahead of the five-year stretch-goal. Outstanding!

Due to the growth in the generosity of our donors, we are happy to say that the urban parishes had their weekly ACUE assessment reduced again. Their financial participation in the schools has been reduced by 25% over the last five years. It is our goal to see the assessment reduced further, but each reduction places greater emphasis on the annual fund for sustainability of our schools. With this said, please know how very much your support means to our schools and parishes, but especially to our students. With your assistance, we will continue to make a significant difference for urban children.

As the 2016-2017 school year came to a close, we wished Holy Cross Elementary principal, Ms. Mary Ellen Matts, all the best in her retirement. An educator for forty-two years, Ms. Matts served the Holy Cross Elementary community for fourteen years, twelve of those years as principal. Ms. Matts loved her school, students and staff, and it showed! We were very sorry to say good-bye, but her legacy to the school and community lives on.

In July 2017, Holy Cross Elementary welcomed new principal, Mrs. Lisa Timmerding. Mrs. Timmerding is brimming with excitement for her new school and leadership assignment.



What She Meant to Us

For nearly 25 years, Diane Russell served as a teacher at Holy Family School located on 16th Street in Covington, the heart of the Austinburg community. Even during her tenure as principal (2011-2016), and for many years prior, she taught kindergarteners, a position perfectly suited to her as she was such a loving, patient presence in the classroom. As the longtime kindergarten teacher, nearly every student in the school, kindergarten through the eighth grade, was touched by her love for them.

The HFS staff received the unexpected, crushing news on the morning of October 31 that Diane had passed away earlier that day. It was Halloween, a day typically filled with fun and excitement for the students. For this reason, the teachers decided to keep the news from the children. Diane would have wanted it that way. When the students returned to school the next day, they were informed of the tremendous loss their community had experienced.

Counselors from our Diocesan Catholic Charities were called to the campus to help the students process their loss and their grief. Students were comforted through the act of drawing and writing about their feelings. The longer they had been at the school, the more memories they had of Diane. Collectively, the students created a rosary and presented it to Dean Russell, Diane's husband.

The loss was felt throughout the Diocese. The other ACUE schools shared their condolences through oversized cards and posters signed by every student, teacher, principal and staff member. When asked by the parishes of St. Mary, Alexandria, and St. Joseph, Cold Spring, what they could do to help, the Holy Family teachers requested Holy Water fonts for each of their classrooms as a remembrance of Diane. We are told that even the non-Catholic children bless themselves with the Holy Water as they enter each room.

Diane was dearly loved, and her spirit is still with us. One little kindergartner from Holy Family School expressed this quite well. He asked the school's kindergarten assistant (who is also the dedicated school secretary), "Mrs. Norris, you told us that Jesus lives in our hearts, but then you said that Mrs. Russell went to live with Jesus. Does that mean that Mrs. Russell lives in our hearts now, too?" Mrs. Norris replied, "Why, yes! She *certainly* does." The little boy gave her a huge smile and then gently patted his chest.



Educational Choice in the Commonwealth

2018 Legislative Update

By Andrew Vandiver, Associate Director, Catholic Conference of Kentucky Educational choice supporters entered the 2018 Session of the Kentucky General Assembly with the wind at their backs. Starting in January, thousands of Kentuckians contacted their legislators to express support for Scholarship Tax Credits.

Yet, the General Assembly did not pass Scholarship Tax Credit legislation or any other bills providing families with educational choice. The 2018 Scholarship Tax Credit bill would have created a \$25 million program which would have incentivized charitable donations to local scholarship granting organizations. It was estimated that over 7,000 students would have received need-based tuition assistance through the program. By design, the majority of the beneficiaries of the program would have been students with special needs, students in the foster care system, or students from families whose income is below eligibility for reduced lunch.

Failure to move the bill was not due to lack of support for the program. Kentucky polling has consistently reflected that a bipartisan majority of Kentuckians support educational choice and Scholarship Tax Credits. Further, a majority of legislators in both chambers of the General Assembly committed to supporting the Scholarship Tax Credit bill.

So what happened? It is safe to say that the issue did not move because the General Assembly prioritized other matters and did not want to take on educational choice. Exhausted from fights over public pensions, tax reform and the budget, the General Assembly opted to kick the can down the road.

So where do we go from here?

We must stay motivated. The battle for educational options has been fought and won in the majority of states, including nearly all of the states surrounding Kentucky. It can happen here. In fact, we have never been closer to passing a bill than we are now.

Victories in other states did not come easy and we should expect the same in Kentucky. The bias towards maintaining the status quo is strong. Nevertheless, **the fight must continue because our children deserve the best educational opportunities possible.**

Scholarship Tax Credits will pass if everyone who reads this takes ownership over the issue and demands immediate action from state lawmakers. We must persuade lawmakers that this is not simply a box that can be checked off at a later date. Educational choice must be a top priority now.

State lawmakers missed a major opportunity to improve the lives of thousands of children and the consequences of their failure to act are serious. The challenges facing families with children who are struggling academically cannot be put on pause while the General Assembly finds a more convenient time to address this issue. For many children, every year that passes without access to more options is a year that is lost with regard to their education.

Take the story of Denisha Merriweather as an example. Denisha received national attention over the last year due the radical change that happened in her life after she was given educational choice. Denisha was on the wrong track academically after failing third grade twice. Her life was changed forever after she was able to enroll in a non-public school that fit her needs through Florida's Scholarship Tax Credit program. She went on to become the first member of her family to graduate from high school and college.

How many Denisha's do we have in Kentucky schools today? These are children who would succeed if their families were only given the opportunity to find the right school. These are children who may be destined for a life of poverty unless they receive immediate help.

Denisha is not the only student who benefited from educational choice. The vast majority of research on educational choice reflects that students benefit across the board when families are given options, regardless of whether they choose a public or a nonpublic school. It is common sense. All children are unique and will have the best opportunity for success if they have access to the classroom that fits their learning needs.

Kentucky families do not have another year to spare. They need options now. This is the message that Kentucky lawmakers need to hear over and over again until they do the right thing and pass a robust Scholarship Tax Credit Program.

In addition to the wonderful support that ACUE has received over the years from Ralph and Irma Drees as Cornerstone donors, Judge Drees has also provided critical support for the EdChoice KY movement. He then provided moral support for the issue through his attendance at the EdChoice legislative luncheon and Kentucky House Education Committee hearing in Frankfort in February 2017. Doing so required him to make a trip to the Commonwealth from his winter home in Florida.

We commend Judge and Mrs. Drees for their incredible support of Catholic education and thank them for being such important ambassadors for our ACUE schools and mission.





Tribute Gifts

In Memory of...Bill Rechtin

In early August 2014, Ray and Darlene Rechtin listened thoughtfully to the summer mission presentation at Immaculate Heart of Mary's 9:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. The presenter spoke about our ACUE schools and the ACUE mission of bringing Christ to the children of the urban core through a quality Catholic education, one that most ACUE families struggle to afford. A second collection took place at the end of Mass to benefit ACUE tuition assistance.



Just days before the ACUE mission talk, Ray and Darlene received the heartbreaking news that their youngest son had been killed in a Miami, Florida house fire. Following Mass, the Rechtins determined that memorial gifts for their son should be directed to ACUE in the form of tuition assistance and school supplies.

William (Bill) Rechtin proudly served in Iraq as a member of the Army National Guard. While at home on leave, his parents asked what he would like in his care packages. "Nothing for me, particularly, not food.

We get plenty of food," was his response. He then looked away momentarily and said something no one understood. The words were Arabic for paper and pencils, something the Iraqi children would request of the American GIs. "If you are going to send me anything, send me paper and pencils." So that is what his parents did.

One of the few photos Ray and Darlene have from their son's time in Iraq features Bill with two Iraqi boys. The photo is a treasure. Bill's sergeant wrote to Ray and Darlene, "You are right about Bill and the kids.

Every time we went out on patrol, we would find a safe spot and the kids would gather. Bill would be the first out to be with them. He was a gentle giant around them, and you could tell he cared very much. There were a couple of times I remember going to the PX and seeing him get supplies and candy for the kids."

As Ray states, "In the midst of war with all its violence, Bill brought a little love to children he never knew. All

of us have that opportunity if not in a war zone, in [the inner-cities] where [for many children] there is little hope. Let's all offer a little hope by making just a little contribution for 'Bill's Kids'."

Bill's Kids completed its fourth anniversary "back-to-school" school supply and tuition assistance collection for ACUE last summer. The Rechtins partnered with fellow IHM parishioner, Amy Ritchie, to organize and oversee the drive which they hold at their parish each year. With each collection, several of our ACUE schools benefit. Supplies that our most disadvantaged ACUE families cannot afford to



purchase for their children are often then purchased personally by the teachers (this is not part of their budget), so the supplies collected by the Rechtins help not only the students and families, they help the teachers, too. The contributions to tuition assistance, the greatest need at our ACUE schools, have been a wonderful added benefit of the Bill's Kids program. The ACUE schools and students are extremely grateful to the Rechtins and IHM parish for remembering Bill in this very poignant, impactful way.
