

Diocese of Covington Pro-Life Scholarship

In an effort to recognize and develop pro-life leadership and convictions among high school age youth, the Diocese of Covington Pro-Life Office will award a \$500 scholarship to current high school aged student to be used to assist in payment of his/her college or Catholic high school tuition.

General Criteria:

- Applicant will have demonstrated a commitment to promoting the dignity of all human life.
- Applicant will have participated in multiple pro-life activities.
- Applicant will submit one letter of recommendation verifying involvement in pro-life activities

Conditions of Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a current student who attends a high school within the geographical boundaries of the Diocese of Covington. (If the applicant is in a Homeschool program, he or she must reside within the geographical boundaries of the Diocese of Covington.)
- Applicant must submit a written application. Application must be received by the Diocesan Pro-Life office on or before April 30.
- Applicant must submit an essay (500 words or less), video (8 minutes or less), or other creative work demonstrating his/her passion for the sanctity of human life. Essays should be typed and double spaced, 12 point type, on standard 8 ½" x 11" paper. Do not identify your name on your submitted work. All entrants are assigned numbers so as to assure anonymity when evaluating entries. Submitted items become the property of the Diocese of Covington Pro- Life Office.
- Applicant may not be a past recipient of this scholarship.

Method of Selection:

- The Scholarship Selection Committee is composed of members of the Diocesan Pro-Life Advisory Board.
- The scholarship recipient will be announced by May 20 and personally notified.
- All applicants will receive letters of recognition.
